Your questions. A documented plan.

The conversation

We discuss how you cook, storage priorities, the look you want, your budget and the questions you want answered. The portfolio records the agreed direction and the decisions still to make.

Sample room and layout direction

Example room: 144 x 120 inches, with a 96-inch ceiling. Keep the sink under the window, use an L-shaped cabinet arrangement, and coordinate appliances on the left return. These are fictional demonstration measurements.

Possibilities and constraints

Review wall-removal ideas, door and window positions, plumbing, electrical capacity and appliance clearances. The sample does not assume any wall is removable. Structural conclusions and required engineering drawings need confirmation by a licensed architect or professional engineer.

Thermal and moisture inspection - included

The actual visit report records inspected locations, instrument readings, photos and recommended follow-up. No readings are invented in this sample. The inspection is non-invasive and does not confirm or rule out mold.

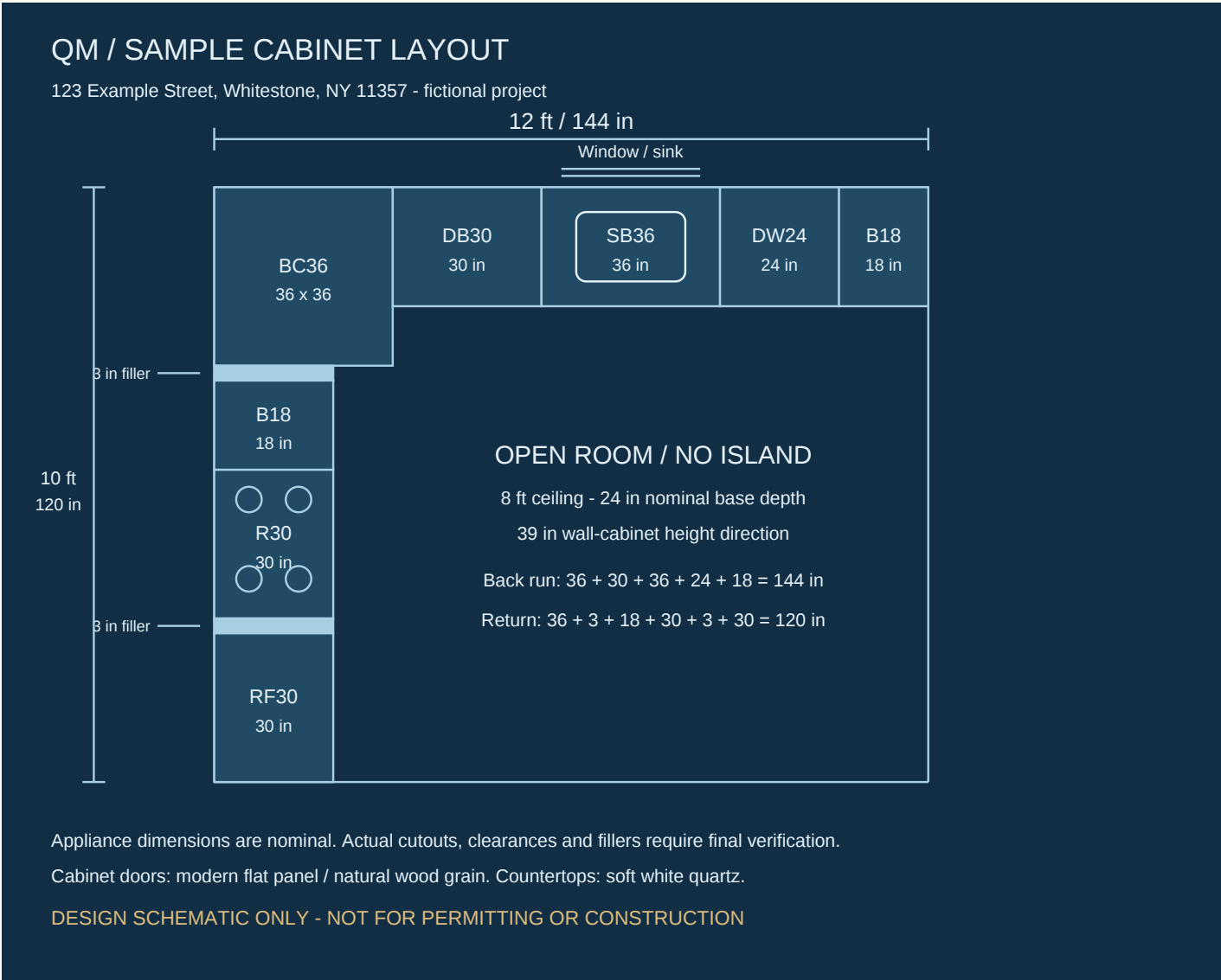
What the written scope resolves

Cabinet layout and sizes; exact product and finish choices; installation responsibilities; allowances; optional upgrades; exclusions and unresolved work. Record each customer question with an answer or the next investigation needed.

02 / THE DIMENSIONED PLAN

Every cabinet has a place.



The back-wall chain totals 144 inches. The return totals 120 inches. Base units are nominally 24 inches deep; the corner uses a 36 x 36 inch footprint. Final clearances and fillers follow the actual appliance specifications.

This sample schematic is a planning illustration. It is not a permit drawing, structural design or release for ordering. The real package is verified against field measurements and the selected manufacturer's cabinet schedule.

Wall-cabinet direction: 54 inches above finished floor to the underside of the 39-inch uppers; 93 inches to the top. Back run: 24-inch corner + 12 + 30 + 36-inch window zone + 42 = 144 inches. Return: 24-inch corner + 30 + 3-inch filler + 30-inch hood zone + 3-inch filler + 30-inch fridge zone = 120 inches.

Nominal sample sizes. Manufacturer specifications, appliance clearances, finish panels and field conditions control the final order.

04 / THE ROOM VIEWS

Your finishes, from two angles.

Soft white quartz counters, coordinated backsplash, brushed brass pulls, a workstation sink and a pull-down faucet. Multiple views help you compare the look and how the room feels before ordering.

These are illustrative style concepts. The dimensioned cabinet schedule controls sizes; your project renderings are prepared from your approved layout and actual selected products.

Brushed brass cabinet pulls

A clean bar profile for doors and drawers. Your portfolio records the selected finish, hole spacing, quantity and model.

Workstation sink

An internal ledge supports prep accessories over the bowl. Confirm the sink size, base-cabinet fit, mounting method and included accessories.

Pull-down faucet

A pull-down spray head makes rinsing easier. Record the exact model, finish, reach, mounting holes and any selected spray functions.

Workstation accessory set

A roll-up drying rack and colander add prep space over the sink. Match the accessories to the selected sink and check which are already included.
